The first canal boat arrived in Caldersburg (now Roscoe Village) in August of 1830. Canal Boat tours began with the Monticello II in 1971 and have continued ever since, taking guests on a ride to the past down the one mile restored stretch of the Ohio and Erie Canal.

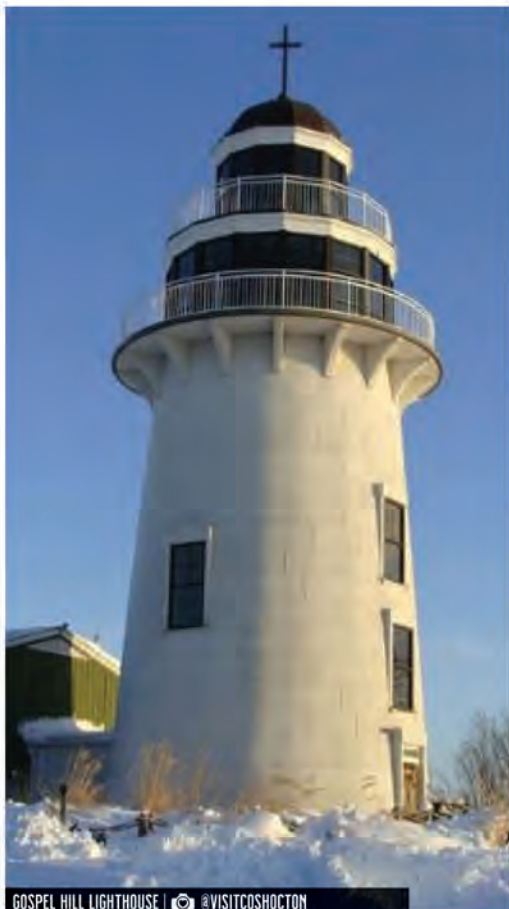

## THE HISTORY BEHIND WHITEWOMAN STREET -

Mary Harris is the earliest identifiable resident of the Coshocton area. In 1704, at the age of nine, she was taken captive by Mohawks in Massachusetts, was adopted and became a Mohawk, married, and had a family. On January 15, 1751, British colonial explorer Christopher Gist visited her town and spoke to her, recording the meeting in his journal. He named the Walhonding river "White Woman's Creek" after Mary, and it was included on English maps. She was world-famous as "The White Woman" living in the wilderness.

Owners Jill & Kevin Sheridan are both Occupational Therapists, but wanted something more. They started crafting together, then teaching others, as a way to bring more creativity into their lives. Jill always wanted to own a small business, and in April 2020, Jill and Kevin turned her dream into a reality with the opening of RUST Decor. Jill wanted to create a big-city experience. "We are a rural community," she said, "and we wanted to provide something in Coshocton that the bigger cities have. It keeps people here to shop and enjoy our community." RUST is proud to be a family business, employing daughters Rylee, Event Coordinator, and Morgan, Barista. "Getting to work with our daughters every day is such a blessing!" Part of Jill's passion for crafting comes with her incredible ability to see value and potential in old pieces of furniture, many of which are destined for the trash. "It's fun to see how you can bring old pieces back and give them a new family to enjoy," explains Jill. Customers bring her multiple pieces of furniture to paint, and as time goes on, those same customers bring her new pieces to renovate for their children.

Over the past four years, Jill and Kevin have purchased and restored two buildings to accommodate the growth of Rust Decor. Now located at 341 Main Street, the much larger space allowed them to expand their workshops and add a cozy coffeehouse that features barista-crafted beverages made

with locally roasted beans. Delectable pastries, snack boxes, salads and sandwiches are available daily, allowing guests to sip, snack, and soak in the creative vibe. Wine and "craft-tails" are available, too!

Rust Decor also features the Pop-in & Paint Studio, where guests of all ages can choose a piece of pottery and create an original work of art – no appointment needed! A wide variety of workshops are offered each month and include charcuterie boards, chunky blankets, centerpieces, wooden signs, painting & macrame. Private workshops are available for parties and groups. Jill plans to add even more community-building activities in 2024. It's easy to spend a day shopping in Coshocton! The Shops of Roscoe Village, the Historic Downtown District and surrounding communities feature a variety of locations and experiences for every type of shopper.

Step onto the brick-paved sidewalks of Historic Roscoe Village and discover more than a dozen locally-owned shops filled with unique items, many of which are created by area artists. Handcrafted leather goods, pottery, fine art, home decor, ladies clothing, fine jewelry, old-fashioned candy, organic pet treats and locally made American flags are just a few of the items that can be found. Shoppers can also enjoy a meal, snack, coffee or adult beverage in one of the four restaurants. Shops are open year-round and many are open on Sundays.

Cross the bridge and explore Coshocton's Historic Downtown District, where charming shops and historic architecture await. Centered around the iconic Coshocton County Courthouse, (c. 1875), shops include a nationally recognized quilt store, a two-story antique mall, and several boutiques filled with clothing, home decor, and fine jewelry. # Thompson Ninety-Nine

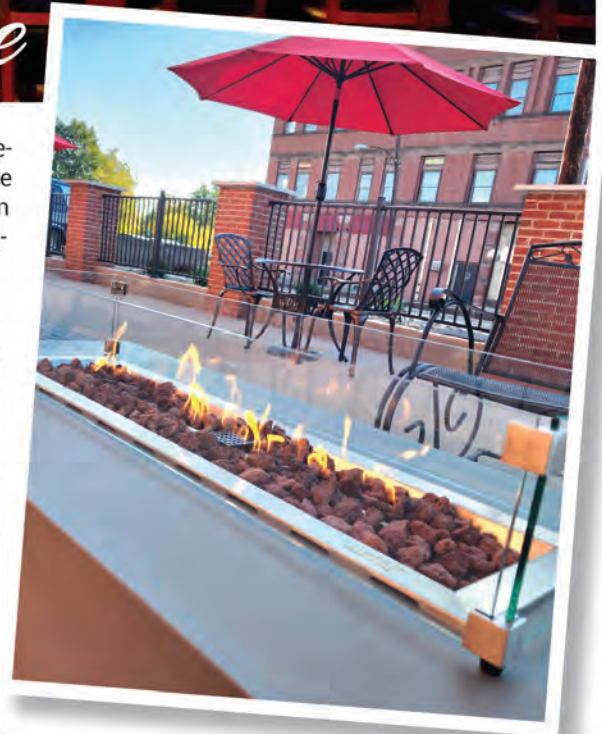

## A CLOSER LOOK



Eins, Zwei, Drei—G’Suffa! One, two, three—Drink! The Woolly Pig Farm Brewery serves up both traditional German lagers AND traditional German brewery fun. German breweries are a key part of community life. Neighbors not only stop by for a beer on a Saturday night but also for a midweek birthday toast with friends or to celebrate cultural festivals marking spring, the harvest and other big days.

The Woolly Pig recreates that atmosphere in Fresno, with its warm and welcoming tasting room, family-friendly environment, and large outdoor space perfect for kids and dogs. And let’s not forget the German festivals—each with their own Woolly Pig twist!

The end of winter always deserves a party! In Germany, Maifest takes place in the beginning of May, marking the arrival of Spring. At the Woolly Pig,



the Maibaum (May Pole) is harvested from the farm and erected in the yard. To celebrate, visitors are invited to grab a ribbon and dance to the strains of a local band. (Bluegrass banjos might not be the classic Maifest accompaniment, but it works in the Appalachian foothills!.) There’s no improving on the Maibock, though! This classic strong golden lager is balanced with a healthy dose of quintessential German hops, and tapped especially for the occasion.

The biggest festival of the brewery year is Oktoberfest, and one has to dig deep into German vocabulary to find the right words! Oktoberfest at the Woolly Pig is marked by tapping of the specially-brewed Festbier from a traditional hand-made wooden barrel called a holtzfass. If visitors don’t have trachten to wear, they can admire the staff in their dirndls, lederhosen and alpine hats (and maybe be inspired for next year)! What would a celebration be without games and party favors? There’s a stein-holding competition for men, women and children alike. And fest-goers can give their sweethearts locally-made lebkuchen, heart-shaped cookie necklaces decorated with flowers and Oktoberfest messages.

November, when nights are long, is the perfect time for the tapping of the Bock beer and for Bierstacheln. Bierstacheln or “beer sting” is the historic practice of gently submerging a red hot poker into a cold mug of something dark and strong. At the

Woolly Pig, the wrought iron pokers (or stachelns) are made by Todd Malenke, a blacksmith and father of the brewery’s owner. Heated to glowing in the outside fire pit, the stachelns cause the Bock to foam thickly, caramelizing the sugars and warming the beer’s head, creating a contrast with the remaining cold, yet robust malty flavors and hoppy bite in the dark amber lager. While this may not be the most well-known German tradition, its authentic and delicious outcome make it a favorite!

Year ‘round, the Woolly Pig Farm Brewery offers a variety of beers and experiences. Come try some old traditions and make some new friends!

## McWane River Walk

Get outside and take a walk or bike ride on the brand new McWane River Walk. This multi-use, paved path connects the Historic Downtown District to Coshocton Lake Park along the scenic Tuscarawas and Walhonding rivers as they converge to form the Muskingum River. The river walk begins at the west end of Main Street behind Coshocton Village Inn and Suites, goes under the SR 541 bridge and passes Skip's Landing, which is home to the Coshocton Farmer's Market from May - October. This Saturday morning market features area producers of seasonal fruit and vegetables, freshly-baked items, poultry, chicken and beef, coffee, kettle corn, art and more. Picnic tables and benches are placed along the path for picnics, reading or relaxing under the old growth trees that shade the path.

Follow the path along the river where it seamlessly joins the Lake Park Connector path, which offers passage under SR36 for safe access to Lake Park, Eagle Ridge Disc Golf Course, and Historic Roscoe Village's Towpath Trail. There are also several water access points along the route for those enjoying a float to pull off. While walkers have access to the water at these points, strong currents make it unsafe to wade or swim. A future extension of the path will connect to the County Road 621 multi-use path scheduled for completion in 2025. The McWane River Walk is made possible by a generous donation from McWane Ductile, an industry leader in the manufacture of water distribution and infrastructure products. Cast iron pipe has been produced in Coshocton since 1878!
